I spend most of my time at Ukarumpa International School, some of my best friends work in the bush alongside speakers of PNG's 830+ languages. These teams do the fascinating work of linguistics, literacy, and anthropology to support many, many churches and communities. To keep translations to a high quality it requires many checks along the way. A few months ago, I was able to travel to Ubuo for the dedication of the gospel of Luke, the 1st completed scripture book in Kope. Pray for our continued work with the people of New Guinea!

Jared has trained a Tunisian to hold his position as the director of finance for NGO. Jared accepted the position of the Tunisia country director.
